1. Locally Grown Farmers' Market

Locally produced fresh fruit and vegetables, breads, as well as arts and crafts are available every Wednesday from June to September. Stroll, shop, and enjoy live music in the heart of downtown Carbondale.

2. Wild West Rodeo

Enjoy a full scale rodeo every Thursday evening during the summer months. You'll find bull riding, calf roping, team roping, mutton bustin', dally ribbon roping, calf scramble for kids, and much more!

3. Hike Local Trails

The hiking around Carbondale provides some of the most spectacular scenery in all of Colorado. Whether you want to stay close to town or take a day hike, there is a trail for you!

4. Rio Grand Bike Trail

If you are a biking enthusiast, pedaling from Aspen to Glenwood Springs is one of the best things to do while visiting Carbondale. The 44 miles of continuous multi-use trail feature many access points- so you can pick the ride that's right for you and your family.

5. Gold Medal Fly Fishing
