Bookkeeper's Report - Executive Summary

Period Ending December 31, 2023, Cash Basis

<u>Lodging Tax Report – Town of Carbondale</u>

- Lodging Tax for October 2023 is \$15,146, a 3% decrease compared to October 2022
- Lodging Tax for November 2023 has not been received as of the date of this report
- 2022 Total (January-December 2022) is \$199,696, a 21% increase over 2021
- TCC Lodging Tax checks from the Town of Carbondale are received 2 months after lodging tax is collected by Town; the amount is unknown until the Town calculates & mails the check

YTD P&L Actuals December 31, 2023 (Blue Column)

- Lodging Tax Income on P&L: \$194,261 Actual vs Budget \$175,000
- December 2023 Lodging Tax Income (\$15,146) is comprised of taxes collected in October
- Total Income: \$201,669 Actual vs Budget \$179,024
- Net Ordinary Income: \$30,143 Actual vs Budget \$1,677
- Net Income including Other Income: \$33,106
- 2023 Budget did not call for funding of Reserve Fund or Opportunity Fund

Balance Sheet as of December 31, 2023 (Blue Column)

- The Operating Checking Account balance is \$57,188 compared to \$103,164 at 12/31/2022; this is due to a \$60,000 transfer from Operating Checking to the Money Market Account in Oct 2023
- Money Market & FirstBank CD cash accounts total balance (Opportunity & Reserve Funds combined) is \$192,622 compared to \$128,203 at 12/31/2022
- Opportunity Fund (Money Market account) reduced by \$14,000 in 2023 to move total
 Farm MAP Grant funds back to checking account for Farm MAP expenses
- Reserve Fund Equity account is \$128,028 (includes MM cash acct interest earnings);
 Opportunity Fund Equity account is now at \$20,174
- Reserve Fund at 12/31/2023 (\$128,028) covers ~67%, or about 8 months, of 2024
 Operating Expenses
