Lodging Tax Report – Town of Carbondale

- Lodging Tax for November 2023 is \$10,777: a 3% increase over November 2022.
- Lodging Tax for December 2023 [preliminary] is \$14,366 and is received by TCC in February 2024, so does not appear on January 2024 financial statements
- 2023 Total (January-December 2023) is \$199,663, a 3% decrease compared to 2022
- TCC Lodging Tax checks from the Town of Carbondale are received 2 months after lodging tax is collected by Town; the amount is unknown until the Town calculates & mails the check

### YTD P&L Actuals January 31, 2024 (Blue Column)

- Lodging Tax Income on P&L: \$10,777 Actual vs Budget \$16,250
- January 2024 Lodging Tax Income on P&L (\$10,777) is comprised of taxes collected in November 2023
- Total Income: \$11,008 Actual vs Budget \$16,597
- Net Ordinary Income: \$4,563 Actual vs YTD Budget \$565
- Net Income including Other Income: \$11,399
- 2023 Budget did not call for funding of Reserves, but the TCC Board voted to fund Reserves by \$20k with Operating surplus funds

# Balance Sheet as of January 31, 2024 (Blue Column)

- The Operating Checking Account balance is \$60,167 compared to \$104,793 at 01/31/2023
- Money Market cash account balance is \$89,356 compared to \$142,233 at 01/31/2023
- Reserve Fund Equity account is \$128,958 (includes MM cash acct interest earnings); Opportunity Fund Equity account is now at \$20,174
- Reserve Funds are now held in both the MM cash account and the CD cash account
- Reserve Fund at 01/31/2024 (\$128,958) covers ~67%, or about 8 months, of 2024 Operating Expenses
